

All-Star Volleyball match held Saturday in Goodland

The eight annual Northwest Kansas All-Star Volleyball Match will be held Nov. 8, 4 p.m. mountain time, 5 p.m. central time in Max Jones Fieldhouse, Goodland.

The match will be played under college rules, with the winner being the team that wins three of five games. At least four games will be played, no matter the result. A fifth game will be played if a tie-breaker is necessary. A selection committee chose 24 volleyball seniors from Northwest Kansas to play, based on their consistently high level of play, statistics and previous honors.

This year's players are from Goodland, Brewster, Cheylin, St. Francis, Oberlin, Oakley, Sharon Springs, Weskan, Atwood, Grinnell, Hoxie, Scott City and Wheatland.

Two Cheyenne County players

were chosen to play in the match. Kandee Raile of St. Francis was chosen to represent the Lady Indians. She is a 5'9" outside hitter. Raile will play on the Whiteshirt team. Sara Moore of Cheylin was chosen to represent the Lady Cougars. She is a 6-foot middle hitter. Moore will play on the Blackshirt team.

This year's coaches are Shelly Hoyt of state qualifying Hoxie, Robyn Garrett, Oakley; Kent Kechter, St. Francis; and Joel Kuchera, Oakley.

Two teams represented in this year's match - Goodland (4A) and Hoxie (2A) - have qualified for their respective state tournaments. Goodland earned the 4A State Championship in the final match on Saturday while Hoxie was eliminated in an earlier round.

Participants at the All-Star Match will receive an all-star shirt and a medal, which will be presented to them by their high school coach during a prematch medal ceremony.

The Most Inspirational Player, as voted on by the players, will receive a plaque after the match, plus a scholarship. Last year's Most Inspirational Player was Shannon Lowry, Atwood. Blackshirts were last year's winners.
