Drivers renewing licenses should expect a new look

As of June 16, those getting their driver's license renewed in the Cheyenne County Treasurer's office, will find their driver's license to have a new look. In fact, the first "temporary" license will be on a piece of heat sensitive pa-

The new equipment, authorized by the Legislature, was installed across the Kansas in state license offices and county treasurer's offices. The equipment was installed to make licenses more secure and harder to duplicate.

The temporary license will be printed out on a piece of heat-sensitive paper which cannot be laminated and is sensitive to the sun and excessive use.

"If left in the sun, the temporary license will soon be black and unreadable. If folded and used a lot, it will also become unreadable,' said Dolores Jenik, county treasurer, adding that if it is lost, it will not be replaced.

Kansas is the first state to implement the new license cards and Colorado is working at it. However, there have been several cases where the temporary license was not accepted. Because of the confusion, people are urged to carry their old driver's license until the new plastic card arrives.

Treasurer Jenik reminds people that they have up to a year before their license expires and if the driver want to avoid the confusion and temporary licenses, they can renew ahead of time.


