BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOV-ERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ST. FRANCIS, KANSAS, that Ordinance number 532 is hereby repealed and that Section 301 of Article 3, Chapter 15 of the 2003 Code of the City of St. Francis, Kansas, and entitled "ELECTRIC RATES; BILLS", shall be amended to read as follows:

15-301.ELECTRIC RATES; BILLS. The rates for electrical power sold by the City of St. Francis shall be as follows:

(a) Commercial Rates, per meter: (1) Monthly Meter Charge \$8.00 (2) First 250 KWH @ 15 cents per (3) Excess of 250 KWH at .10750

cents per KWH (b) Domestic/Residential Rates, per meter:

(1) Monthly Meter Charge \$8.00 (2) .10750 cents per KWH (c) A charge of \$3 per month shall be added to the above and foregoing rates for all service provided for customers outside the city limits of St. Francis.

(d) Electric bills shall be rendered monthly as provided in Section 15-222
