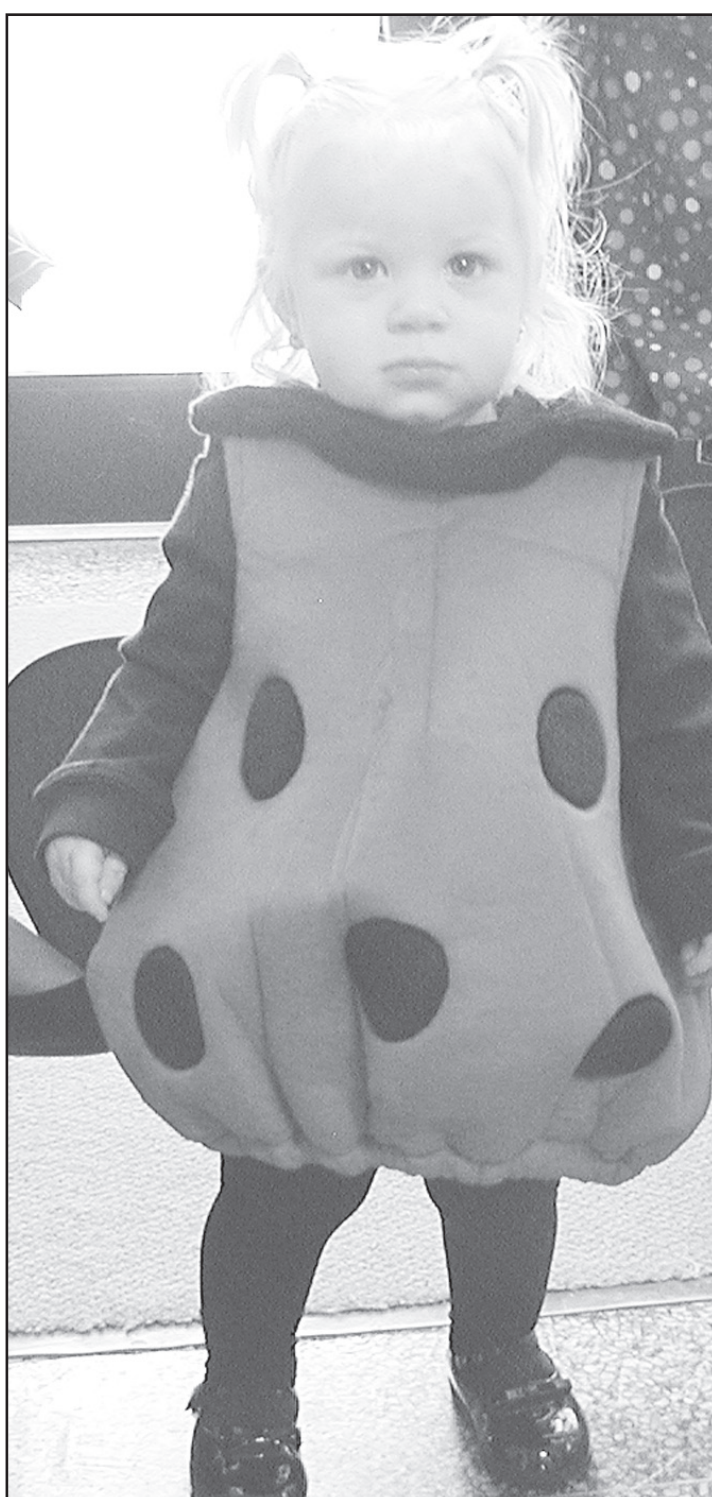


Halloween parade was lots of fun
