Section 1. OPERATION OF WORK SITE UTILITY VEHICLES AND ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES; PENALTY

(i) All work-site utility vehicles and all-terrain vehicles shall be equipped, maintained and operated so as to prevent excessive or unusual noise.

(j) All laws, ordinances and other rules of the road that are applicable to the operator or occupant of a motor vehicle within the city limits are also applicable to operators and riders of work-site utility vehicles and all-terrain vehicles.

(a) Work-site utility vehicles and all-terrain vehicles may be operated upon the public highways, streets, roads, and alleys within the corporate limits of the city between sunrise and 10 p.m.

(b) No work-site utility vehicle shall be operated on any public highway, street, road, or alley unless such vehicle shall comply with the equipment requirements under the provisions of article 17, chapter 8 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated.

(c) No all-terrain vehicle shall be operated on any public highway, street, road, or alley after sunset, unless equipped with lights as required for motorcycles.

(d) No person shall operate a work-site vehicle and all-terrain vehicles on any public highway, street, road or alley within the corporate limits of the city unless such person has a valid driver's license.

(e) No person under the age of 18 years shall operate or ride upon a work-site utility vehicle or an all-terrain vehicle unless wearing a helmet which complies with minimum guidelines established by the national highway traffic safety administration pursuant to the national traffic and motor vehicle safety act of 1966 for helmets designed for use by motorcyclists and other motor vehicle users, along with applicable eye protection.

(f) No person, except those expressly exempted, shall driver or operate any work-site utility vehicle or all-terrain vehicle upon any street in this city unless such person has a valid driver's license. Any person under the age of sixteen (16) that does not have a driver's license, solely due to the fact that they are not eligible for the same as a result
