Commissioners appoint committees

At the first of every year, the Cheyenne County Commissioners reorganize, appoint committees, banks and decide on meeting times, just to name a few.

The first priority is selecting a chairman for the coming year. Andy Beikman was re-elected for this position.

Mutual agreements with Cheyenne County Municipal Airport, city of Saint Francis for Fire Department, and the city of Bird City for fire and Ambulance were approved and signed.

The *Saint Francis Herald* and *Bird City Times* were designated as the official county newspapers. First National Bank and Bankwest were designated the official county banks.

The commissioners will continue to meet on the 15th (or day closest to the 15th if the 15th is on a weekend) and the last working day of the month, with meetings starting at 8 a.m.

Commissioner Ernie Ketzner was appointed as the Kansas Legislative Policy Group representative and Commissioner Beikman as the alternate. Dues of \$827 were approved.

The commissioners will check with their respective Airport Authority Members and see if they are still interested in being on the Board. Members are Ron Loudon (District 1), Rick Rogers (District 2), and Mike Callicrate (District 3).

Terry Miller, clerk, Justin Barrett, county attorney, will work on the employee handbook and the update regarding a sick-leave pool.

The commissioners agreed to give a 5 percent cost of living raise.
