ORDINANCE NO. 550

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 212 OF ARTICLE 2 OF CHAPTER 15 OF THE 2003 CODE OF THE CITY OF ST. FRANCIS, KANSAS, AND PROVIDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT TO THE CITY OF ITS COSTS INCURRED IN THE TESTING OF WATER ME-TERS FOUND TO BE ACCURATE AND INCREASING THE TESTING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOV-ERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ST. FRANCIS, KANSAS, that Section 212 of Article 2, Chapter 15 of the 2003 Code of the City of St. Francis, Kansas, shall be amended to read as follows:
