Highway is under road construction

People wanting to travel on K-27, north of U.S. 36 to Haigler have experienced a wait. The road is under construction and there is one-way traffic which requires a pilot car in the lead.

Eric Oelschlager, Kansas Department of Transportation engineer out of Atwood, said he expects the stretch of 27 to be done

by Tuesday, Wednesday at the latest. The road crew will then move to the river bridge and start east going through St. Francis on the way to the Wheeler-K-27 south junction.

Mr. Oelschlager said the four-lane stretch through St. Francis will have a lot of activity. He said plans were not complete yet, but they are strongly considering using two lane traffic on one

side while the other side is being worked on, then they will change to the other side.

Mr. Oelschlager cautions drivers to be especially careful while the work is being done on the four-lane road. There's going to be a lot going on, he said, and there will be lots of heavy equipment and trucks.

The work going through St. Francis should be completed by

the end of the week and the road construction will be completed to Wheeler by July 1, weather permitting and there is no breakdown of equipment.

The construction, Mr. Oelschlager said, is going well and there have been few complaints. The crew is making a real effort to get done before wheat harvest arrives.

Therapist receives scholarship award

Physical therapist at the Cheyenne County Hospital, Shara Johnson, was recently notified that she was one of 13 people to receive a scholarship award from Kansas health care organizations

The Kansas Hospital Association announced the successful completion of the eighth annual Health Care Scholarship Program through the Kansas Hospital Education and Research Foundation. In addition to nine Kansas Hospital Education and Research Foundation scholarships, the Kansas Hospital Human Resources Association and the Kansas Association of Health Care Executives provided four additional

scholarships for a total of 13 scholarship recipients and 12 alternates. The Scholarship Review Committee reviewed 165 applications from 115 individuals.

Mrs. Johnson is working on a doctorate in physical therapy and received the master's scholarship, Cheyenne County Hospital;

Each application was reviewed by two members of the Scholarship Review Committee according to established criterion. The highest scoring applicants for each category became finalists and were reviewed by the entire committee.
