Also scoring in double figures was Teryn Carmichael with 18 points. She was 44 percent (7/16) from the field and 67 percent (4/6) from the line.

"I knew that this was going to be a tough game against a strong Dighton team," Coach Greg Jones said. "Our girls fought from beginning to end and were able to pull away in the last few minutes.

"We still need to work on reducing our turnovers and remaining calm when the pressure is one."

Defensively, Cheylin had 27 rebounds with Busse having a double-double night, scoring in double figures and rebounding in double figures. She had a total of 14 boards with eight offensive and six defensive.






