It provided that any person - It provided that any person who arrived at the age of 21 years, and is a citizen of the United States or who shall have filed his declaration of intent to become such and who has
never borne arms against the United never borne arms against the United
States government or given aid and States government or given aid and
comfort to the enemy, is entitled to comfort to the enemy, is entitled to
160 acres of land in certain areas or 80 acres if taken in more favorable areas.

Example: a Railroad Grant. In most areas, the application fee
was $\$ 14$ and an additional $\$ 4$ when was $\$ 14$ and an additional $\$ 4$ when final proof was made. This varied

From the date of application, usually called filing, 6 months was
allowed for making improvement and on or before the expiration date, the homesteader had to be on the land and begin improvements. He was further required to make this his permanent residence for 5 years
