Cooperative annual meeting held in Sainty

Wednesday evening, Nov. 2, nearly 100 members and guests attended the 94th annual meeting of the Wheeler Cooperative Mercantile Equity Union, held in the St. Francis high school cafeteria.

Following the meal, entertainment was provided by the high school Advanced Music class, under the direction of Debbie Fiala. The business meeting was then called to order and conducted by board president Rex Murray.

Audit, financial and operating reports were presented by Dale Weeks, manager. For the fiscal year ended May 31, the company reported a profit of over \$400,000. Mr. Weeks discussed the cash portion of the patronage, stock payout for members over 80 years of age, and a revolving stock payout program for the company.

Mr. Weeks also reviewed the operations of the previous year, noting the number of bushels handled, number of railcars and trucks shipped, the installation of new equipment, and general operations of the company.

"We are a strong company," Mr. Weeks said. "We've worked hard this past year. That's what we do."

Bruce Feikert was elected to the board to replace Steve Busse,

who had served for 12 years and reached the company's by-law term limit. Mr. Weeks thanked his employee group and the patrons, and concluded the meeting by drawing for door prizes.

After adjournment, patronage checks were distributed to eligible members in attendance.

There will be park-and-drive zero turn mower demonstrations in front of the Kiplinger Arena, sponsored by Kurtzer's Walker Mowers.

Rodeo athletes this year include professional bull fighter Quirt Hunt, world champion steer wrestler Dean Gorsuch and world champion bareback rider Will Lowe, along with Miss Rodeo Nebraska. They will be at the expo both days, signing autographs along with rodeo queens from the area.

Drawings will include tickets to the Tri-City Storm Hockey team. A beer garden will be offered. Corporate sponsors include Plains Equipment Group, Hometown Family Radio and the American Hat Co.

"Our parking lot counts from last year showed vehicles from 37 Nebraska counties, 20 Kansas counties, 13 Colorado counties and 10 other states," Dale said.

Cougar football season ends

The Cougars played their last game last Tuesday night, ending their season with a loss to the Victoria Knights 36-18.

Cheylin had a winning season with a total record of 8-2 and went 6-0 in the Western Kansas Liberty 8-man football league. This season, the team had wins over Wauneta-Palisade, Neb., Wheatland-Grinnell, Wallace County, Golden Plains, Weskan, Natoma, Greeley County and Triplains/Brewster.

There were six ball players with a total of 2726 rushing yards and 37 touchdowns for the team. Jeremiah White led the rushing stats with 2006-yards in 235 carries, scoring 32 touchdowns and 16 conversions. Austin Manners with 363-yards in 83 carries and scored eight touchdowns and 16 conversions. Kenan Reeh had 196-yards in 59 carries with three touchdowns and four conversions. Adam Orten ran for 125-yards in 22 carries with two touchdowns and two conversions. Ty Carmichael ran for 20-yards in nine carries and Eddie Frisbie ran for 19-yards in nine carries.

In the air, Reeh completed 24 of 52 passes for 391-yards. Ethan Young caught 16 of those passes for 264-yards and seven touchdowns and four conversions. Walker Janicke caught three passes for 41-yards, scored one touchdown and two conversions. Manners received three passes for 28-yards, scoring one touchdown and 16 conversions. Joshua Keltz caught one for 36-yards and Will Orten caught one for 22-yards.

On defense, Noah Jones had 62 unassisted tackles, 81 assists and four quarterback sacks on the season. Manners had 50 solo tackles and 52 assists. A. Orten had 27 unassisted tackles, 32 assists and two sacks. Young had 24 solo tackles, 56 assists and four sacks. White had 21 unassisted tackles and 11 assists. Reeh had 19 solo tackles and 40 assists. Janicke had 12 lone tackles and 23 assists. Ruben Razo had nine solo tackles, 36 assists and three sacks. Carmichael had six solo tackles, 31 assists and three sacks. Cory Rucker had five lone tackles, 37 assists and one sack. Keltz had five unassisted tackles, 35 assists and two sacks.

Luis Solis had five lone tackles and 16 assists. Shawn Pochop had three unassisted tackles, seven assists and one sack. Heath Churchwell had three unassisted and four assisted tackles. Frisbie had two unassisted and 10 assisted tackles and Austin Cobb had one unassisted tackle, four assists and one sack.

Also on the defensive side of the ball, White had six interceptions and knocked one pass down, Manners had three interceptions and seven passes deflected, Young snagged three interceptions and deflected two passes, Janicke and Jones both got two interceptions each, Reeh had one interception and three pass deflections, A. Orten had one interception and one deflection and Churchwell had one interception.

Other members of the team were Senior Dalton Magnani and Freshmen Michael Barnett and Jacob Brubaker.

Rachel Keltz was the team manager.

Coaches were Max Keltz, Dennis Hengen and Anthony Blair.
