| By Casey McCormick <br> mccormickcasey＠rocketmail．com <br> Last week I wrote about the tow－ er at the Liberty Memorial in Kan－ sas City that honors the soldiers of World War I．An interesting story goes along with the place． <br> Housed in one of the stone halls there is a portion of Le Pantheon de la Guerre．What the painting is and how it arrived in the American mid－west deserves a moment． <br> The word panorama comes from the Greek＂pan＂meaning all and＂horama＂view．Before the advent of motion pictures pan－ oramas were used to tell a story to the viewer．While Paris was be－ ing bombed in October 1914， 130 French artists began work on the Pantheon de la Guerre．It would not be completed until after the Armistice four years later． <br> The final work was 45 feet tall with a length of 402 feet．It repre－ sented the Allied nations， 28 in all， and depicted over 6，000 individual leaders，heroes，martyrs and com－ mon soldiers．The original cost was said to have been $\$ 500,000$ in early 20th century dollars． <br> A special round building was |
