Haiti. Later they found out that a Brazilian plane had caught on fire in Haiti and the runway was shut down for two days.
As the team waited in line for instructions on what to do next, they were told the next flight would be on Wednesday morning for them to go to Haiti. Amazingly, God moved
upon a lady, who worked in the airport, to help the team, giving them transportation to the store to buy food for their next two days, and even taking them to the beach on Tuesday to enjoy the day and get out of the hotel room. The lady commented, as her daughter asked
what we were doing there, "Mom, how can we bless them?
Wednesday finally arrived and the team was able to fly to Haiti. Once in Haiti, they school in the city of Cité Soleil, which is senoorally regarded as one of the poorest and most dangeros areas of the Western in the Northern Hemisphere. From there they viewed the beginnings
