Becker Foundation visits local groups

Four members of the Todd Becker Foundation attended the Wesleyan Church on Sunday. The foundation had presented an assembly at St. Francis Community High School in January of 2010, and Cheylin

High School in August of 2011. Both former Superintendents, Scott Carmichael, St Francis, and Bruce Bolen, Cheylin, were impressed with the impact the foundation team had on the students at that time.

Andy and Kara Johnson, Kirsten Klein, and Emily

Malmkar from Kearney, Neb., just finished working with the team in Holcomb, and were on their way to McIntosh, S.D. for the next assembly.

The foundation was started by Todd's older brother Keith after Todd's untimely death in a drunk driving wreck. Todd had everything going for him as the starter in the football team, finalist in pole vault competition, and dreams of playing baseball in college. In his senior year he lost it all because of his tragic choice. Over 30,000 high school students in the midwest have been impacted by this presentation. Wesleyan's youth who had participated in the 2010 and 2011 assembly and concert had the opportunity to chat with this group during the pot luck following church.

The foundation workers travel throughout the midwest putting on assembly presentations in the high schools. The assemblies focus is based on Todd Becker's

death and how it could have been prevented. Keith tells the students of Todd's tragic death and challenges students to take the narrow road, according to the scripture of Matthew 7:13. The focus of the story is on making wrong choices and their consequences. In the evening the program includes live music from the touring band, "Chye" in concert and is a time for the youth to dedicate their lives to Christ.

The foundation's reasoning in putting these assemblies on in the schools is to reach students before they turn 18, as 70 percent of commitments are made before the age of 18. After that the odds are against them.

The adults not only had a chance to chat with this group but they also had an opportunity to meet and chat with Wesleyan's district superintendent, Pastor Ed Rotz and his wife. They were on their way to Colorado Springs for a mountain retreat.

Notice is hereby given that the agreement between the Secretary of Health and Human Services and NW Kansas Home Care, 820 South Denison, Saint Francis, Kansas, operated by The Evangelical Lutheran Good Samaritan Society, as a home health agency provider in the Health Insurance for the Aged and Disabled Program (Medicare) is to be terminated at the close of October 16, 2013.

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services has determined that NW Kansas Home Care, located in Saint Francis, Kansas is not in substantial compliance with Medicare regulations for Home Health Agencies.

The Medicare Program will not make payment for post-hospital extended care services furnished to patients who are admitted after October 16, 2013. For patients whose plan of care was established on October 16, 2013, or earlier, payment may continue for up to 30 days of post-hospital extended care services furnished after October 16, 2013.
