Cheylin's FFA livestock judging team had an impressive showing last week when they took 1st place as a team at district livestock judging. Jacob Brubaker placed second overall as an individual. Other team members included Allie Frisbie, Ivan Kemp, Reece Leonard, and Elizabeth Keltz. Diana Garcia participated in the green hand division.

The Cheylin track team kept their season rolling last week as they traveled to Hoxie for a nine team meet. The golf team got their season going when they traveled across state lines for their first meet of the season in Benkelman. Let's take a look at both teams early season performances.....

Golf

The golf team had a beautiful day for their first meet of the season, however, the Cougar men got off to a bit of a shaky start. The Cougars couldn't recover from their early on struggles as they ended with an overall team score of 407.

For those of you wondering, the four best varsity golfers have their scores added together for the team score. This is the first time in quite a while that the Cheylin varsity has been over 400 as a team.

A bit of tough day, but it was on grass-greens. Our boys usually play pasture golf on sand-greens. On the bright side, Eddie Frisbie placed 12th overall, shooting a 93. Jacob Brubaker placed fourth in the junior varsity division, shooting a 54 on a shortened 9-hole contest.

The 407 team score placed Cheylin 5th out of 10 teams.

Track

Now for the track team: Ladies first as always.

Allie Frisbie grabbed silver in the 300m hurdles. Shayla Hubbard just missed the top three with fourth in the 800. The 4 by 400 team placed second and the 4 by 100 team placed third. Kalin Ritchie ran for fourth place in the 1600m run. The girls put together

another impressive relay, placing second. Allie Frisbie grabbed another medal on the day placing third in triple jump. The ladies had 34 team points, placing them at the bottom of the eight team field.

The men had a bit of a rough day as well. However, some of the highlights of the day included Walker Janicke snagging bronze

in the discus and fourth in the shot put. Janicke number two (Devon) placed fourth in the triple jump and third in long jump. Reece Leonard placed fourth in the 3200m. The boys placed sixth as a team with 48 team points.... and they beat Saint Francis (Wooooo!). At any rate a fine effort put forth by both of our track teams.

Both spring sports teams are going hard as they approach the beef of their seasons. The golf team is back in action this Thursday when they travel to Lacrosse for their first sand-green meet of the season. The track team gets back in action April 25th when they travel to Oakley. GO COUGARS
