

School district seeking a new board member

The Norton School District is looking for a new member for its board.

Darin Schuckman resigned his position at Monday night's meeting because he and his family are moving out of town.

Superintendent Greg Mann said the vacancy will need to be published and then people would have 15 days to request that they be se-

lected. After that a new member can be appointed.

Mr. Mann said the new board member would serve until July 1, 2005, following the general election in April of 2005. The new member can run in the election if he or she chooses.

He said whoever is elected will serve a two-year term and will then have to run for re-election in 2007. After that, the term will be for four years.

Mr. Mann recommended that those who are interested submit a letter with their qualifications and reasons they want to be on the board by Friday, May 7.

In other business, the board:

- Accepted the resignation of Peggy Stull as the high school art teacher. She is retiring after 26 years with the district.

- Set a special meeting for noon Friday, April 30, to complete its

personnel deliberations. Mr. Mann said the state statute requires that teachers be told if they will have a job next year by May 1.

- Accepted the resignation of Lida Sharp as the National Honor Society sponsor, a the end of this year.

- Approved the board goals. A special meeting was held in February to develop goals to guide the board. The final goals have been worked on by the superintendent and the Kansas Association of School Boards' facilitator.

- Heard a report from Board Member Elaine Lofgreen on the March meeting of the North Central Kansas Special Education Cooperative.

The Dane G. Hansen Museum in Logan is hosting an exhibition of tin containers dating back to the late 1800s. The show is the result of 50 years of collecting by Liz Knitter, Downs.

Ms. Knitter began purchasing tin and cardboard containers from little shops here and there while living in California. What started with some neat old tea boxes, a Coors Malted Milk tin and a few attractive cosmetic tins, soon became a full-fledged collection. She now has nearly 1,600 tins and related items including tobacco, food product, pharmaceutical, candy, cosmetic, talcum, typewriter and household tins.

Highlighted in this show will be about 500 tins from her collection.

Ms. Knitter said that tins have become a desirable collector item.

She said that she collects tins for the beauty, nostalgia and just for the fun of it.
