

Northern Valley track teams competed at Osborne meet

The Northern Valley Huskies took sixth place with 39 points in the Osborne Invitational, while the Lady Huskies scored 19.25 points for 13th place. The meet was on

April 23. “Jesse Hilburn set personal bests for the year in the 300m and 110m hurdles,” said Coach Lonnie Brungardt. “Cody, Avery and

Casey each had personal bests in sprints in the 4 x 800. “Cody Lowry had a 28 second improvement in the 3200, while Janelle Fritz improved by 21 seconds in the 1600. Lindsey Graham had one of her better shot put throws.”

Scoring for the Huskies were: Second place — Jesse Hilburn, high jump, 5’10”, and 300m hurdles, 42.83; Joey Copper, 110m hurdles, 15.77;

Third place — Lindsey Graham, discus, 99’2”, and shot put, 33’3.5”; Kelli Cole, high jump, 4’10”; Hilburn, 110m hurdles, 16.31;

Fourth place — Clarke Nelson, pole vault, 10’9”; Cole, triple jump, 30’9”;

Fifth place — Joey Copper, triple jump, 38’6.5”; Avery Thalheim, Cody Lowry, Zack King and Casey Dole, 4 x 800m relay, 10:33.61.
