City Parking Ordinance Published in The Norton Telegram on

Friday, July 16, 2004. (1T) ORDINANCE NO. 1530

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE FINE FOR VIOLATION OF NON-MOVING PARKING VIOLATIONS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS:

Section 1: Section 14-103 of the Code of the City of Norton is hereby amended to read as follows:

14-103 Penalty for Scheduled Fines. The fine for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or any other traffic offense for which the Municipal Judge establishes the fine and the fine scheduled shall be not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$500.00, except that speeding shall be not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$500.00. A fine for a nonmoving parking violation shall be \$25.00. If said parking violation ticket is not paid within 72 hours, the fine shall be increased to \$50.00. A person tried and convicted for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or other traffic infraction offense for which a fine has been established and a scheduled fine, shall pay a fine fixed by the court not to exceed \$500.00.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be effective upon publication in the official City newspaper.


