Norton City Parking Ordinance

Published in The Norton Telegram on Tuesday, December 7, 2004. (1T)
ORDINANCE NO. 1540

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING VEHICULAR PARKING, EXCLUDING PASSENGER BUSES, ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF WILBERFORCE STREET IN NORTON, KANSAS, STARTING AT THE EASTERN TERMINUS OF STATE STREET AND WILBERFORCE STREET, THEN WEST 307 FEET.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS:

Section 1: That from and after the effective date of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle,

excluding passenger buses, on the south side of Wilberforce Street from the eastern terminus of State Street and Wilberforce Street, then west 307 feet.

Section 2: Violation of this ordinance shall be punishable in accordance with the provisions of the Standard Traffic Ordinance of the City of Norton, Kansas.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its publication in the official city newspaper, and the signs being duly placed.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Governing Body of the City of Norton, Kansas, this 1st day of December, 2004.

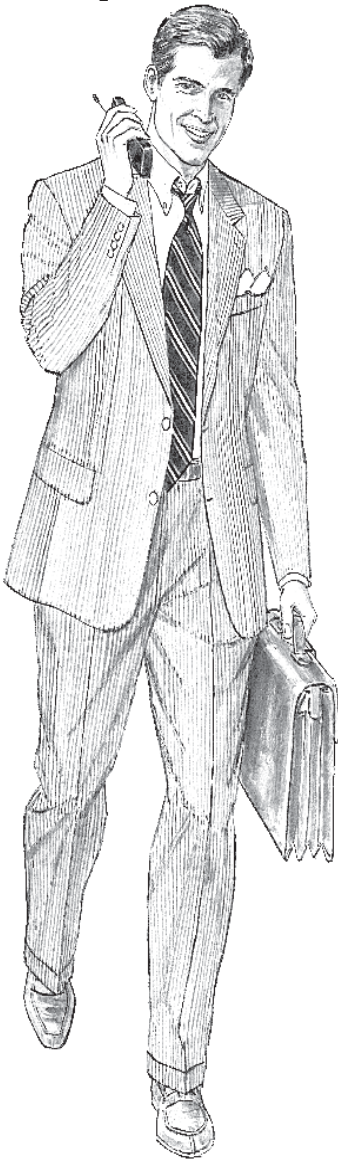
