Northern Valley Huskies take on Osborne Bulldogs

The Northern Valley Huskies were defeated 65-42 by Osborne on Tuesday.

“After having watched Phillipsburg and Osborne play the night before, I knew we were going to have to show up and play our best,” said Coach Jason Dibble. “Osborne had one of their starters out and Henry Griffiths was unavailable due to sickness.

“For the first half, we played extremely well and did a good job of shutting down dribble penetration on the defensive end and being patient and getting high percentage shots on the offensive end. This resulted in a five point game at half with three of their players in foul trouble.

“In the second half they went to a 2-3 zone and we were unable to manage much offensively the whole half. We need to be able to attack a zone with dribble penetration and quick ball movement and not rely on the three, because lately we have not been shooting them real well. We talk about taking good shots, but sometimes against zones we need to take better shots.

“In the first half we kept pushing the ball up the floor and getting Joey a lot of good looks and trips to the freethrow line. In the second half, we had some unforced turnovers and quick shots that led

to easy baskets for them.

“They are a good team and we need to keep things in perspective with three very good opportunities coming up the next three games. Things are getting tighter for the regional picture, but if we take one game at a time and take care of things in our control we will be just fine.”

Joey Copper led scoring with 27 points, followed by Avery Thalheim, 10; Jesse Hilburn, 3; and Cole Kinderknecht, 2.

Rebounding honors went to Copper with 5, followed by Kinderknecht, 3; Hilburn, Thalheim, and Andrew Sheley, 1 apiece.

Thalheim led steals with 2, followed by Hilburn, Clarke Nelson, Kinderknecht, and Copper, 1 each.

Hilburn led assists with 4, followed by Thalheim, 3; Copper, 2; and Sheley, 1.

Copper made the team’s only block.

The junior varsity team was edged 25-24 by Osborne.

“We gave ourselves a chance,” said Coach Dibble. “This is a big statement for these kids because we were down six going into half, but fought back in the second half and fell one point short of winning the game.

“We ran through our offense and gave ourselves some good looks.

At the end of the game we were down four and Chad Husted hit a three, we called a timeout and got a steal and got fouled on the inbounds. Unfortunately we were unable to hit the freethrow, but again give the players’ credit for being right there at the end.”

David Harris led scoring with 12 points, followed by Cody Lowry, 5; Scott Shearer, 4; and Chad Husted, 3.

Rebounding honors went to Chase Miller, 5; Harris, 3; Lowry, Bryce Marble, and Shearer, 2 each; and Nelson and Chance Miller, 1.

Nelson made the team’s only 2 steals, while Chase Miller, Anthony Simants and Lowry made the team’s 3 assists.
