Almena City Ordinance Regulating Sound Systems

Published in The Norton Telegram on Friday, April 7 and 14. (2T)

ORDINANCE NO. 403
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF SOUND AMPLIFICATION SYSTEMS IN MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF ALMENA, KANSAS

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Almena, Kansas, finds that the use of loud sound amplification systems in motor vehicles within the City constitutes a general nuisance to the public and should be prohibited;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ALMENA, KANSAS:

Section One. Article 2 of Chapter XI of the Code of the City of Almena, Kansas, is hereby amended by adding the following section:

"11-201 LOUD AMPLIFICATION SYSTEMS PROHIBITED:

a. No person operating or occupying a motor vehicle on a street, highway, alley, parking lot or driveway shall operate or permit the operation of any sound amplification system from within the vehicle so that the sound is plainly audible at a distance of 50 or more feet from the vehicle;

b. **Sound Amplification System** means: any radio, tape player, compact disc player, loud speaker or other electronic device used for the amplification of sound;

c. **Plainly audible** means: any sound produced by a sound amplification system from within the vehicle, which clearly can be heard at a distance of 50 feet or more. Measurement standards shall be by auditory senses, based upon direct line of sight. Words or phrases need not be discernible and bass reverberations are included. The motor vehicle may be stopped, standing,

parked or moving on a street, highway, alley, parking lot or driveway."

d. It is an affirmative defense to a charge under this section that the operator was not otherwise prohibited by law from operating a sound amplification system, and that any of the following apply:

1. The system was being operated to request medical or vehicular assistance or to warn of a hazardous road condition;

2. The vehicle was an emergency or public safety vehicle;

3. The vehicle was owned and operated by the City of Almena, Kansas, or a gas, electric, communications or refuse company;

4. The system was used for the purpose of giving instructions, directions, talks, addresses, lectures or transmitting music to any persons or assemblages of persons in compliance with ordinances of the City of Almena, Kansas;

5. The vehicle was used in an authorized public activity, such as a parade, fireworks display, sporting event, musical production or other activity, which has the approval of the department of the City authorized to grant such approval.

e. Violations of this section shall be punishable as provided by Section 1-116 of the Almena City Code.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published in the official City newspaper and shall take effect upon publication.

City of Almena Charter Ordinance

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 404
A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF ALMENA, KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 15-209, PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS ON THE SAME SUBJECT AND REMOVING LIMITATIONS ON RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ALMENA, KANSAS:

Section One. The City of Almena, Kansas, by the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects to and does exempt itself and make inapplicable to it the provisions of K.S.A. 15-209, which applies to this City, but is part of an enactment which does not apply uniformly to all cities, in so far as said statute requires that the appointed officers must meet residency requirements.

Section 2. The governing body of the City of Almena, Kansas, shall be qualified electors of said City.

Section 3. City officers and employees appointed pursuant to K.S.A. 15-204 need not be qualified electors of said City, but must be qualified electors of Norton County, Kansas.

Section 4. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two (2) consecutive weeks in the official City newspaper.

Section 5. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect 61 days after the final publication in the official City newspaper, unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed, requiring a referendum to be held on the ordinance as provided by Article 12, Section 5, subsection (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this Charter Ordinance shall become effective upon approval by the majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED by the governing body of the City of Almena, Kansas, not less than two-thirds (2/3) of the members elect voting in favor thereof, this 3rd day of April, 2006.
