

# Norton man turns fruit into wine

Dale Carlson recently shared his unique hobby of wine making with the members of the Norton Lions Club.

Mr. Carlson has been making wines for years, getting started when he still lived in Canada. He said he made a lot of raspberry wine there.

Since coming to Kansas he has discovered that his favorite is cherry wine. He said he has made some nice pear wine, too.

He started his hobby from the ground up, even making his own crusher. He told the club about the help he had from local craftsmen. Jerry Bantam helped with some of the mechanisms, Ed Witt helped build part of the grinding device and Bud Posson helped with the metal "teeth" of the crusher.

Mr. Carlson demonstrated how efficient the grinder is and also how he corks and uncorks a bottle.

He labels his wine with the flavor and the year it was made.

He shared a tip to judge the alcohol content of a wine. The liquid should be swirled in the glass. It will leave lines, called "legs". The more legs, the higher the alcohol content.

In other business, the Lions Club learned the highway clean-up will be held May 16.

A Norton woman and her daughter were relatively uninjured after being in a car accident on April 30.

Patsy L. Maddy, Norton, fell asleep at the wheel of a 1997 Ford Taurus while driving back from Phillipsburg on U.S. 36. They were about four miles east of Norton when the accident happened.

A report from the Kansas Highway Patrol said Mrs. Maddy fell asleep, went into the south ditch, and then woke up. She drove back onto the road, but overcorrected and went back into the ditch, striking the guard rail.

Both Mrs. Maddy and her 10-year-old daughter, Marissa, were taken to the Norton County Hospital.

Mrs. Maddy said Marissa was uninjured, except for a little scratch on her forehead. As for herself, she said she had a scrape on her knee and some bruises.

"She (Marissa) was asleep and had her seat belt on," she said. "We were very lucky and thankful we had angels around us. We're also thankful the guard rail was there."

"I always wear my seat belt but for some reason I didn't have mine on," she said. "The air bags deployed and I think that helped us from getting hurt."

Mrs. Maddy said she was stiff and sore last week, but is getting better every day.

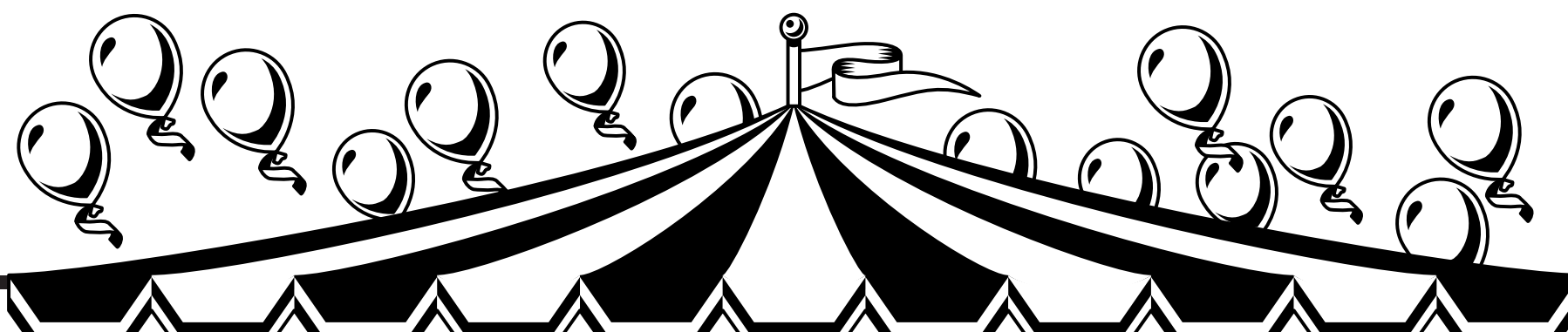
