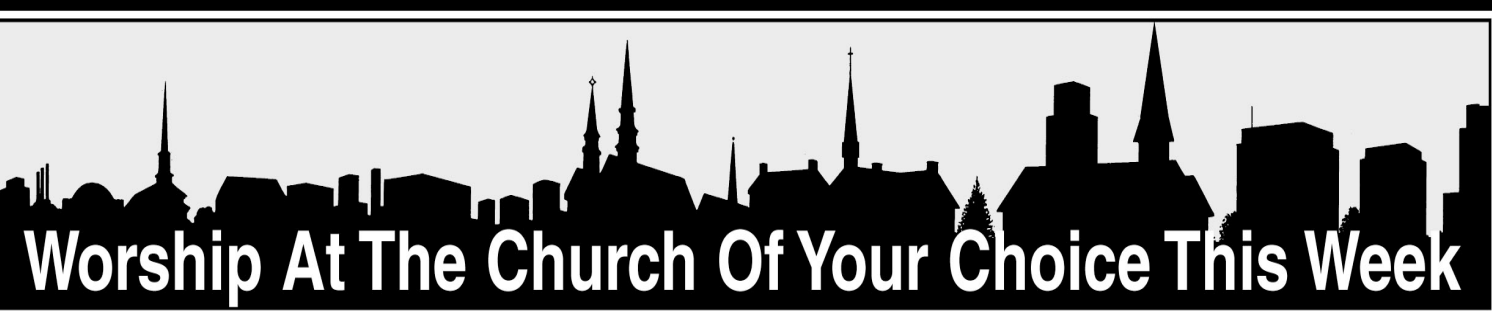
# ALMENA NEWS
