The 5-feet-7-inch Cox and 5'9" Bozarth were both named to the second team.


Both girls were also honored last year at the end of the season when Cox was also chosen to the second team and Bozarth received honorable mention.

Following an intersquad meet in Wichita on Friday, Dec. 7, the Wichita State Shockers' indoor season will officially open in the Kansas State University All-Comers Meet on Saturday, Dec. 8 in Manhattan.
