


Firing a salute to honor fallen soldiers was the honor guard from the Norton American Legion.

These veterans, many still able to fit their uniforms, kept in step as they marched in the Veterans Day Parade




Committed to having a good time, the Crimson Cuties of Norton are the local chapter of the Red Hat Society. They all piled into the back of a truck for the parade.


