


Leading a riderless horse, with boots in the stirrups backwards, was Eugene Wiltfong. The rider carrying the American flag was Dave Donovan.



John K. Gallentine, Clayton drove his 1953 John Deere Model "D" in the parade.









All gone! This little guy showed his empty container to the crowd, proving he was all out of candy.
