 AN ORDINANCE VACATING A SECTION OF MANOR DRIVE IN THE WESTRIDGE ACRES ADDITION TO THE CITY OF NORTON, NORTON COUNTY, KANSAS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF NORTON, KANSAS:
 Section One. That the governing body of the City of Norton, Kansas, deems it necessary and expedient to vacate all of Manor Drive east of the Southwest corner of Lot 1, Block 3 of the Westridge Acres Addition, an addition in the City of Norton, Norton County, Kansas, all as contemplated by K.S.A. 14-423, and that the same should be, and is hereby vacated.
