





FARMWORKER: DRIVES TRUCKS ON HARVEST RUN AND DOES INFIELD REPAIRS ON EQUIPMENT

Must have appropriate driver's license with air brake endorsement if available in state drive forage trucks. Must furnish and produce to employer a current "driver's abstract" showing an acceptable driving record. The employer, Mr. Rogers from Long Island will pay the adverse effect wage rate of \$9.55/hr.
