In an 1892 Supreme Court Decision on the case, *Church of the "Holy Trinity v. United States"* this ruling came down; "Our laws and our institution must necessarily be based upon and embody the teaching of the Redeemer of mankind. It is impossible that it should be otherwise; and in this sense and to this extent our civilization and institutions are emphatically Christian. This is a religious people. This is historically true. From the discovery of this continent to the present hour, there is a single voice making affirmation. We find everywhere a clear recognition of the same truth. These, and many other matters which might be noticed, add a volume of unofficial utterance that this is a Christian nation." (Justice Brewer delivered the opinion of the court on February 29, 1892)
