commandment, "Be sanctified." Sanctification is the process of being made holy. Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, writes: "But just as He who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: 'Be holy, because I am holy." (1 Peter 1: 15 - 16)

God's commandment written to us through Paul cannot be more clear and there is no higher calling than to be in the center of God's will.

It is important to understand that sanctification, holiness and consecration are synonymous terms. The word "holy" conveys the following ideas.

1.) The word holy conveys separation: Holy is a word descriptive of God's nature and its root meaning is separation. This does not mean that Christians are to lock themselves up somewhere away from the world; rather they are to be in the world, yet not governed by this world's system. 
