Psalms 22:28 says, "for dominion belongs to the LORD and He rules over the nations." The King James Bibles says, "...He is the governor among nations."

The University of Houston, Political Science Department researched the sources our Founding Fathers used most frequently in forming our present system of government. He unashamedly used Scripture, referring to chapter and verse for every principle of law he cited. For **Tax Exemption for Churches our Founding Fathers** looked to Ezra 7:24. And for the inscription on the Liberty Bell, the Speaker of the Pennsylvania Assembly asked that a portion of Leviticus 25:10 be used.


