The Kansas Historic Sites Board of Review will consider the following properties located within an unincorporated area of the state for listing in the Register of Historic Kansas Places and the National Register of Historic Places at its meeting on August 16, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. at the Kansas State Historical Society, 6425 SW Sixth Avenue, Topeka, KS 66615. This National Register-listed bridge is currently located on the line between the NW 1/4 of Section 3, Township 5S and the SW 1/4 of Section 34, Township 4S, Range 23 W. Norton County is proposing to relocate the bridge to Larrick Park at the intersection of the abandoned Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way and Elk Creek in Lenora, Norton County, Kansas.
