Gabel said he took no pleasure in breaking the news to the

"These schools have enroll-

he said.
The school boards from the

league will decide if they are

on Jan. 22.
The reason Colby may be
leaving the Northwest Kansas
League is because of the enroll-
ment decline in many of the
leagues schools.
Today Colby and Goodland
are the only Class 4A schools
in the league, Gabel said. They

baseball and tennis programs.
