Members of Logan's 4 x 100 meter relay team won gold medals with a winning time of 45.66. Running for the Trojans were sophomore Brady Tien, junior Tyson Pabst, sophomore Charlie Becker and senior Levi Kiser.

Tien and Kiser also qualified for the state meet in the pole vault. Tien vaulted 12' to place second and Kiser cleared 11'6" to finish fourth. Becker placed fifth with a clearance of 11", just missing state qualifying.

Pabst also qualified for the state meet in the 110 meter hurdles with a third place finish in 16.72. Tien placed sixth in 17.32.

Kiser just missed state qualifying in the 100 meter dash where he finished fifth in 12.06. Tien also finished sixth in the 300 meter hurdles with a time of 44.13.

Trojan sophomore Mark Pakkebier also just missed state meet qualifying with a fifth place finish in the discus with a season best throw of 128'2". Just behind him in sixth was teammate senior Charley Harmon with a throw of 127'8".

Harmon also was seventh best in the shot put with a personal best heave of 39'7.5". Pakkebier heaved the shot 36'5" to finish in 14th spot.
