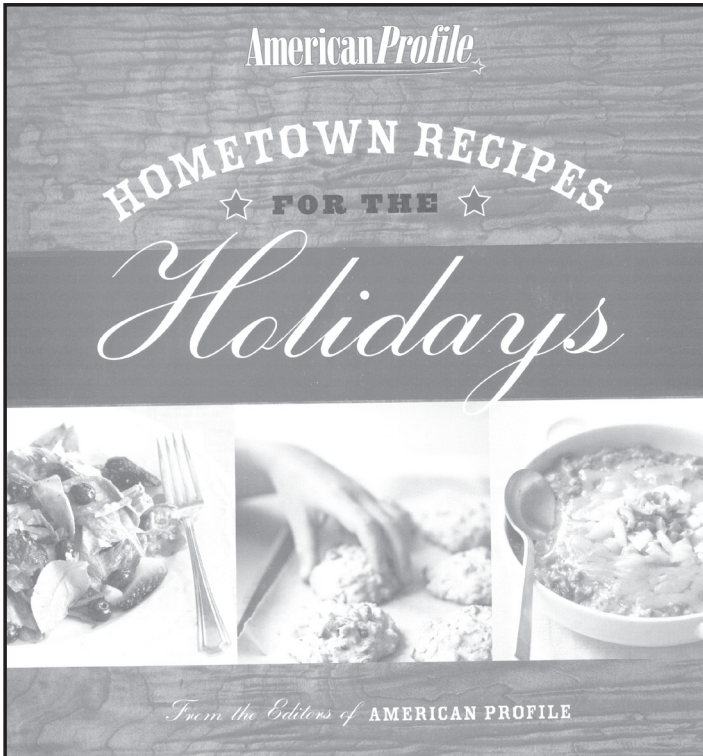

NOTICE OF BOND ELECTION

TO: THE ELECTORS OF ALMENA, KANSAS

WHEREAS, A Resolution directing the calling of a bond election for submission to the voters of City of Almena, Kansas (the "City"), of a proposition of the City to issue General Obligation Bonds in a total principal amount which shall not exceed \$260,000, was duly adopted by the Governing Body of the City on November 1, 2009 (the "Resolution").

NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned Election Officer of Norton County, Kansas, by virtue of the authority vested in him by law and the Resolution, does hereby proclaim and give notice to the electors of Almena, Kansas, that a bond election has been called and will be held in the City on December 8, 2009, at which there shall be submitted to qualified electors of the City, the following proposition, together with voting instructions as required by law:

"Shall the Following Be Adopted?"

Shall the City of Almena, Kansas issue General Obligation Bonds, to be issued in an amount not to exceed \$260,000, for the purpose of paying the costs of constructing and equipping a community building to house a public activity and meeting room, library and City offices in the City of Almena?

The polls will open at 7:00 o'clock A.M. and will close at 7:00 o'clock P.M., on December 8, 2009, the election day. The voting place in the City shall be the regular polling place.

City Building, 415 Main Street, Almena, Kansas

The election will be conducted by the officers and/or persons provided by law for holding elections, and the method of voting will be by ballot. Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-1117 et seq., registered voters are eligible to vote by advance voting ballot upon application to the Norton County Election Officer. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The City is providing the following additional information in compliance with K.S.A. 10-120a. This information has been obtained from sources deemed reliable by the City. Certain of this information is based upon projections as of the date hereof, and no assurances can be given that these projections will be accurate as of the date of issuance of the proposed bonds due to changes in bond market conditions, changes in the City's assessed valuation, and other matters unknown or unavailable at this date. Projected this date. Projected rates of property taxation cited in this information to be used to pay the principal of and interest on the proposed bonds and ad valorem property tax rates on property located within the City of Almena, Kansas, based upon the current assessed valuation of the City, and upon an assumed principal repayment schedule and average interest rates from recent bond issues for similar types of financings, all as set forth below.

*Reflects estimated debt service on anticipated 20-year bond financing. The City may be eligible for 10-year reduced rate financing which would increase average annual principal and interest payments to \$27,621.67 with an annual mill levy impact of 23.48 mills over ten years.
