As word got out, the personnel grew gradually to the present 24 to 28,” Mr. Russell said. “The band is appreciative to the school district for use of their music equipment, as well as the loyal audiences who attend the performances.

The band now includes musicians from the Oberlin and McCook area. They play several concerts a year, along with concerts for special occasions.
