ORDINANCE NO. 348  
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING RATES CHARGED FOR THE USE OF WATER WITHIN THE CITY OF LENORA, KANSAS  
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LENORA, KANSAS:  
Section One. That Section 15-225 of the Code of the City of Lenora, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:  
“RATES. The rates per month for the use of water in the City shall be as follows:  
(a) The water rates for users of water on premises within the City shall be \$28.50 for the first 3,000 gallons used and an additional \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons used over the 3,000 gallon minimum.  
(b) The water rates for users of water on premises outside the corporate limits of the City shall be \$28.50 per month for the first 3,000 gallons used and an additional \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons over the 3,000 gallon minimum.”  
Section Two. Ordinance No. 280 is hereby repealed.  
Section Three. This Ordinance shall be full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in the official City newspaper.


