

Norton senior signs intent

 Luke Ninemire, an excellent 6' 215 pound senior offensive guard and defensive tackle for Norton Community High School, has signed a letter of intent to play football for Highland Community College in Highland.

The rugged Ninemire is a four-year letterman for Norton head football coach Lucas Melvin and was a stalwart on the Blue Jays' 9-1 season in 2010.

Luke is a second team selection on both offense and defense for the All-Mid-Continent League post-season team by vote of team

coaches.

From his defensive position, Ninemire was Norton's fourth highest tackler this past season with 30 solos, 18 assists for 48 total tackles.

"Luke was recruited to play outside linebacker for Highland," said coach Melvin.

"He always played a defensive and offensive lineman for us but is athletic and aggressive enough to play outside linebacker.

"If he continues to work hard as he always has for us, he will have a good chance to play for them."

"We are very excited here at Highland to be able to sign a stu-

dent-athlete the quality of Luke," said Chris Douglas, recruiting coordinator for Highland Community College football.

"Recruiting quality has definitely improved in our second year at Highland and that fact is exemplified by being able to attract Luke.

"We anticipate Luke coming in and competing right away for a linebacker spot on our team.

"I am hopeful now that we have Luke at Highland, it will help us attract more players along Highway 36."

Luke is the son of Peggy and Jim Ninemire.

Jeff Wolf confirmed that he had checked with the Register of Deeds located in the Norton County Courthouse and that Kevin Wiltfong is the owner of record of the properties.

The public hearing was closed at 6:10 p.m.

The Council took up the allegations on the Notice and Order issued on Dec. 3, 2010 and based on the evidence made certain

findings.

The Council found that the properties were in violation of Environmental Code, Health Nuisances, and Property Maintenance Code.

Justina Smith asked if the doors were taken off the refrigerator and refrigeration units that are on the property if they would be allowed to stay. Karen Griffiths stated that the items are still in violation and should be removed.

Karen Griffiths will prepare a resolution for approval at the

next council meeting and asked the council what time frame they wanted for clean-up of the items. The Council approved a motion to have the City Attorney prepare a Resolution, ordering the cleanup of the properties located at 507, 509, and 511 N. Graves and granting a time of 45 days for the cleanup of the weeds, environmental and health issues and 60 days for the property maintenance violations.

There being no further business, the Council adjourned.

The Norton County BB Gun shooters placed runner-up in the 2011 Northwest Kansas Regional 4-H Shooting Sports Match on Saturday, February 26 in Oakley.

Six members of the Norton County Rotary BB Gun Team competed as individuals and four of the shooters made up the Norton County Team.

Shooters competed from the prone, standing, sitting and kneeling positions. There was no written test.

Placing for Norton County individually and their scores were: Trenton Sprague, runner-up, 364; James Berry, fifth, 358; Dalton Vanover, seventh, 350; Cameron Heikes, ninth, 344; Scott Sansom, 11th, 340 and Shane Cozad, 20th,

307.

Trenton Sprague was runner-up among 12-14 year olds, James Berry was fourth, Dalton Vanover sixth and Cameron Heikes seventh. Scott Sansom was third among 10-11 year olds and Shane Cozad was tenth.

Members of the four-person Norton County team were Trenton Sprague, Dalton Vanover, Cameron Heikes and Scott Sansom and their total shooting score was 1398.

Phillips/Rooks County won the championship with a team score of 1439. Golden Prairie was third with an 1185, Edwards County placed fourth with a 969 and Sheridan/Gove County finished fifth with an 808.

Following a runner-up finish the week before in 4-H regional shooting in Oakley, the Norton County BB Gun Team sent ten young marksmen to Hays for the 2011 Ellis Regional 4-H Shooting Match on Saturday, March 5 and they returned with another runner-up team placing.

The ten members of the Norton County Rotary BB Gun Team competed as individuals, then scores of the top four from each county were compiled into team scores.

As in the regional shoot in Oakley, shooters competed from the prone, standing, sitting and kneeling positions and there was no written test.

Placing for Norton County individually and their scores were: Riley Goss, age 8, seventh, 247;

Adson Day, age 9, runner-up, 311; Dylan Goss, age 10, fifth, 324; Dallas Gosselin, age 10, sixth, 323; Scott Sansom, age 10, tenth, 308; Miles Harrington, age 10, 11th, 293; Justis Posson, age 11, third, 365; Trenton Sprague, age 12, runner-up, 373; James Berry, age 12, fifth, 364; Cameron Heikes, age 13, seventh, 361.

Phillips/Rooks County won the championship with a four-person total team score of 1474. Norton County was just 11 points back with a 1463 for runner-up. Third place went to Sedgwick County with a 1402 and Edwards County was fourth with a 1325.

The four top Norton County shooters who made up the Norton County Team were Trenton Sprague, Justis Posson, James Berry and Cameron Heikes.
