"A Mother's Question

God's Word is full of instructions on how to live in a way that could enable your children to enjoy the abundant life promised in Christ. Mothers who want to influence their children for Christ will take to heart what is written in Philippians 2:3 and 5, "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus."

She denied herself certain pleasures in order to have the finances and especially the time to help oversee the spiritual training of her children.

He is now a pastor of a church and he makes this plea, "Mothers, be sensitive to your children's need for turning off the television and worldly distractions and make time to plant seeds the Holy Spirit can use to lead your children to Christ.
