AN ORDINANCE AMENDING RATES CHARGED FOR USE OF WATER WITHIN THE CITY OF ALMENA, KANSAS BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ALMENA, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE. Section 15-224 of the Code of the City of Almena, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"RATES. The rates per month for the use of water in the City shall be as

(a) For customers within the City: \$25.00 per month for the first 3,000 gallons used, and an additional \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons used over the 3,000 gallon minimum. (b) For customers outside the City: \$30.00 for the first 3,000 gallons of water used and an additional \$2.00 per 1,000 gallons used over the 3,000 gallon minimum." SECTION TWO: Ordinances of the City of Almena, Kansas, in conflict with the terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE: This ordinance shall be published in the official City newspaper and shall take effect on August 19, 2011.
