ORDINANCE NO. 424 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ALMENA, KANSAS, TO ALLOW CONSUMPTION OF CEREAL MALT BEVERAGES ON THE PREMISES OF THE ALMENA COMMUNITY BUILDING BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ALMENA,

KANSAS:

SECTION ONE. Subsection (b) of Section 3-102 the Code of the City of Almena, Kansas, is hereby amended to provide as follows:

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to drink or consume any cereal malt beverage or alcoholic beverage in any public place not licensed to sell and serve such beverage for public consumption at such public place within or under the jurisdiction of the City; excepting, however, that any person may serve, drink or consume any cereal malt beverage within the premises of the Almena Community Building when such activity has been specifically authorized by usage agreement or license approved by the governing body of the City. Nothing in this section authorizes the retail sale of cereal malt beverages within or upon the premises of the Almena

Community Building." SECTION TWO. Section 12-110 of the Code of the City of Almena, Kansas, is hereby amended to provide as follows:

"It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to use, consume or possess on the premises of any park, public school or City property within the City any alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage; excepting, however, that any person may possess or consume any cereal malt beverage within the premises of the Almena Community Building when such activity has been specifically authorized by usage agreement or license approved by the governing body of the city.
