Zoning changes in your neighborhood. A proposal to increase your property taxes. Information on how public officials are spending your tax dollars. Your local newspaper fulfills an essential role in serving your right to know. After all, it shouldn't be your responsibility to know how to look ... where to look ... when to look ... and even what to look for in order to be informed about public information. It is the government's responsibility to notify you of public information, and your local newspaper is the most accessible place to find it.
