

JV golfers play well in Goodland, Hill City tourneys

The Norton Community High School junior varsity golfers played their best of the young season on Tuesday, April 17 in the Goodland JV Invitational as they earned five of the top six medalist scores.

No team scores were kept but Norton junior Cassius Dole was low medalist for the day with a 44. Blue Jay junior Javen Colip was runner-up medalist with a 45. Norton junior Ryan Bainter was third medalist, also with a 45.

Jonah McClung, Goodland, was fourth medalist with a 47. Fifth medalist was Norton

senior Taylor Meder with a 47 and Norton freshman Chance Uehlin was sixth medalist with a 47. Other medalists were Caleb Yaune, Dundy County, 47; Chris Rotherham, Dundy County, 47; Blake Bergling, Atwood, 47 and Michael Blodgett, Atwood, 49. Also playing for Norton was junior Jordan Hartwell and he shot a 56. “What an outstanding performance by our junior varsity golfers today!” said Norton head golf coach David Stover. “To earn five of the top six individual medalist honors is quite an accomplishment. “Cassius Dole won the top in-

dividual tournament honors for the first time in his Norton career today but I am very pleased with the performance of all our golfers. All of our players played well today and are making great strides in improvement.”

The junior varsity team placed fourth in the JV Invitational Golf Tournament in Hill City on Friday, April 13. Phillipsburg won the championship with a 176, followed by Hill City Black, 180; Ellis, 182; Norton, 190; Trego Community, 194; Ness City, 196; Plainville, 205; Hill City Red, 228; Brewster, 249; Stockton, 257; Hill City White, 322.

Junior Ryan Bainter was low scorer for Norton with a 44, followed by freshman Chance Uehlin, 46; junior Javen Colip, 48 and sophomore Garret Otter, 52. Also playing for Norton and their scores were junior Dustan Daniels, 52 and junior Vaughn Newman, 59. Bainter was sixth medalist and Uehlin was 14th medalist. golf all day and Chance Uehlin earned an individual medal in his first golf tournament for Norton. I was also pleased with the play of Javen Colip and Garret Otter.”
