"Essential Elements for Marriage"

Once a couple understands God's love and allows Him to place His love within them, they can properly apply the four principles found in Genesis 2:24-25. The first principle is, "For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife ... " (Genesis 2:24) This is God's divine revelation to a couple who want to enjoy marriage, "Til Death Do they Part."


In order for a marriage to enjoy all that God wants a couple to experience, there must be a separation. The significance of the language, "leave" is that marriage involves a new pledge to a spouse in which former familial commitments are superseded by commitments to each other. Do not read more into this statement than the Lord intends. This does not mean that a couple abandons their parents, nor are they not to listen to their parents' wise counsel. While continuing to honor their parents, couples are to first honor one another.


