



## Quintet performs music in Colby

Table for 5 will be presented at 7:30 p.m. on Friday, Nov. 30, at the Cultural Arts Center at Colby Community College. The program is sponsored by Western Plains Arts Association. Admission is by season ticket or at the door.

The vocal quintet will perform *Home for the Holidays*, a program of Christmas favorites including carols, popular songs and light fun numbers. *Do You Hear What I Hear*, *White Christmas* and *Parade of the Wooden Soldiers* are among the mix of selections they are planning to sing. The repertoire will feature some a cappella arrangements and

some accompanied by piano and/or guitar.

*Table for 5* originated with *A Victorian Christmas*, which attracted sellout houses in Chicago and established the ensemble as an audience favorite. Since then, they have expanded their repertoire and have appeared in numerous and varied venues, including symphony orchestras, in concert halls, and as guests for university art series.

This event is made possible in part by the Kansas Arts Commission, a state agency, and National Endowment for the Arts, a federal agency.

## Travel service is improved

A new service has been initiated by the Kansas Department of Transportation to help travelers get road conditions quickly and easily.

The 511 Mobile becomes part of the department's Traveler Information network, which includes phone and Internet access to the

latest weather and road conditions for Kansas highways.

Highlights of each service and its changes include:

- 511 Mobile – <http://511mm.ksdot.org>.

A new service that provides the following information on a Blackberry or other handheld, mobile device, such as a Smart phone, is:

- A list of closed roads and driving conditions on Kansas highways. Currently, does not include maps or graphic information

Department of Transportation officials reminds people not to use this service while driving.

#### Web site

The 511 Web site provides a map that shows road condition and construction/detour information for Kansas highways as well as links to other travel information, including the official Kansas State map and weather. This site can now also be accessed directly from department's Internet home page at <http://ksdot.org> by clicking on the "closed roads and driving conditions" (orange) box.

Web site upgrades include:

- New page layout.
- Larger, more detailed map that is easier to read and use.
- Closed roads list.
- Revised driving conditions list.

Kansas 511 phone system

Call 511 from anywhere in Kansas or 1-866-511-KDOT (5368) from anywhere in the U.S.

Kansas 511 is a free service (cell minutes may apply) that provides route-specific road conditions, road work information, emergency closures, and travel weather information for Interstate, U.S. and Kansas state highways, as well as Kansas Turnpike routes.

Kansas 511 also provides similar information for Nebraska and phone numbers for callers to access road weather information in Colorado, Missouri and Oklahoma. With updates every 15 minutes, Kansas 511 can also be a resource to help keep you informed about changing weather conditions. The service is available at all times by using any phone.

Now, the phone number for obtaining Motor Carrier information is provided. Soon, all reports will use landmark references (cities, junctions, etc) instead of mile marker references for easier understanding of referenced locations.

The Department of Transportation encourages those traveling for the holidays to use these services to plan their trips or to get en route updates; but for everyone's safety, do not to use them while driving.
