

Helping to find a child

The St. Francis Masonic Lodge Kansas Child Identification Program (KS CHIP) will be held from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Monday and Tuesday at the St. Francis Elementary School.

On the average in the United States, a child is reported missing every 43 seconds. Most parents don't have the proper items ready at a moment's notice that may help save their child's life.

Through the Masons, this program will give complete child identification kits to the parent or guardian. The Masons keep nothing.

Each child progresses through the various stations including a video imaged interview, fingerprints, digital still photo and a DNA cheek swab.

"This is a free service provided by our lodge to all parents and guardians," said Rodney Ritchey, lodge member. "If you have a child not currently attending school, they are also invited to participate."

A separate permission slip and information sheet is needed for each child. The information is either given to the individual child or it can be held at the school for the parent to pick up.
