

Football season ends; stats are revealed

The St. Francis Indian football team had another successful year. They finished the season with nine wins and two losses.

The final game of the season was a regional playoff game with LaCrosse and the Leopards finished the game with a 38-30 win.

Sainty was the District 15 champion, and the bi-district champions, advancing to the regional game.

Ten seniors, Trent Kinen, Jesse Pacheco, Trevor Hilt, Tyler Larson, Casey House, Scott Ford, Ethan Zwegardt, Lance Owens, Shawn Warren and Sam Sowers, finished their high school career.

Senior Taylor Kennedy was a manager for the squad this year.

Sainty defeated all of their Northwest Kansas League opponents who play 11-man football including Colby, Goodland, Hoxie, Oakley and Rawlins County during the regular season and Decatur County in bi-district; also Syracuse and Wichita County/Leoti in district play. They also met two teams in the Mid-Continent League, Phillipsburg and Norton. The Norton game was their only loss in the regular season. LaCrosse was their second loss and that happened in regional play.

Raile for a total of 272 yards, averaging 38.86 per carry, the longest being 85 yards; Kinen, four for a total of 87 yards, averaging 21.75 yards per carry, the longest being 42 yards; Lamb, four for 20 yards, averaging 5.0 yards per carry; Zwegardt four for 15 yards averaging 3.75 yards per carry; J. Pacheco, two for 6 yards, averaging 3.0 yards per carry.

Punts: T. Raile, 19 for 657 yards, averaging 34.58 yards per punt, the longest punt being 47 yards.

Punt returns: T. Raile, four for 92 yards, averaging 23 yards per return, the longest return being 72 yards; Kinen, one for 5 yards, averaging 5 yards per return.
