Young Texas man injured in accident

A benefit soup supper and dance is being planned for Blayze Bahe starting at 4 p.m. mountain time on Saturday, March 6, at the Goodland Elks Club.

Blayze, 24, had a motorcycle accident on Nov. 18. He was on his way home after work with an oil company. The accident happened after dark near the Dallas Cowboy Stadium in Arlington, Texas. Construction was going on and he had hit a barrier which threw him in the ditch.

His grandmother, Sharon Deeds, Goodland, said the sheriff had received a call that there was a motorcycle at the scene so an officer picked up the motorcycle at 3 a.m. but didn't look to see if a driver was there. It was raining and Blayze laid in the ditch all night.

The next morning at 7 a.m., a construction worker found him and he was rushed to the hospital. He had a temperature of 80 degrees. He "coded" two times, Mrs. Deeds said, but was brought back to life. He was

in a coma for a couple weeks, then on kidney dialysis for another two weeks.

He spent a month in a Dallas hospital, was transferred to a Great Bend hospital then released before Christmas. Nine days after entering the hospital, Blayze's parents took time to go to his apartment in Fort Worth and found his dog. Mrs. Deeds said the dog was hungry and thirsty but OK. He is now living in Great Bend.

"It is a miracle that he is alive," Mrs. Deeds said.

He has had several surgeries and part of a leg has been amputated.

"He has a great outlook," Mrs. Deeds said.

Blayze is the son of Randy and Kathy Bahe of Great Bend and he is recuperating there. His grandmother, Sharon (Byerly) Deeds, the daughter of the late Andy and Flossie Byerly, was raised in St. Francis.

Mrs. Deeds said the outpouring of calls and prayers has been overwhelming and very much appreciated.


