American Cancer Society's Daffodil Days are here.

This is the second year Mr. Yonkey has helped with Daffodil Days. He supports the program. When a member of your family has cancer, he said, you know how important cancer research is.

Daffodil Days is one of the American Cancer Society's oldest fundraisers. It celebrates the Society's mission to eliminate cancer as a life-threatening disease by offering daffodils to donors in appreciation of their contributions.

For more than 30 years, Daffodil Days has enabled people to join the fight against cancer by raising funds and sharing hope for a future where the disease no longer threatens loved ones.

There are three different price ranges including a \$25 bunch which also includes a bear. There is a sunshine bouquet which includes a vase for \$15 and an individual bouquet of 10 daffodils for \$10. The person can order as many bouquets as they want.

There is also the "gift of hope" which is a bouquet of daffodils delivered anonymously to those who have been touched by cancer. The flowers will be delivered to hospitals, treatment centers, nursing homes and churches on the donor's behalf.

## Storm spotter training held

There will be a storm spotter and safety class in St. Francis starting at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday, March 16, at the high school cafeteria.

The class, sponsored by the National Weather Service in Goodland and the Cheyenne County Emergency Management, is free of charge. It is open to anyone with an interest in helping their local community by reporting severe

weather events to the National Weather Service.

The program is conducted only once a year by National Weather Service meteorologists, so consider attending this fun and educational training. The class will discuss thunderstorm formation, organization and evolution, associated clouds and their meaning, thunderstorm hazards, safety, and what and how to report.


