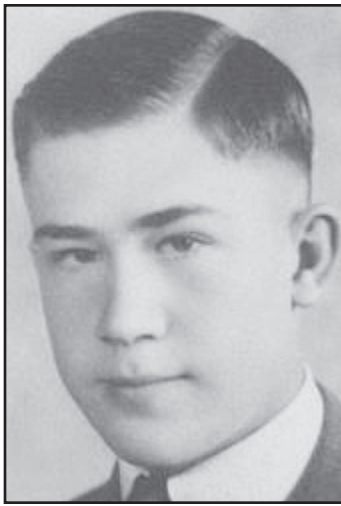
Richard graduated from Bird City High School in 1939. After graduation, he attended college at Fort Hays State before entering the service.
